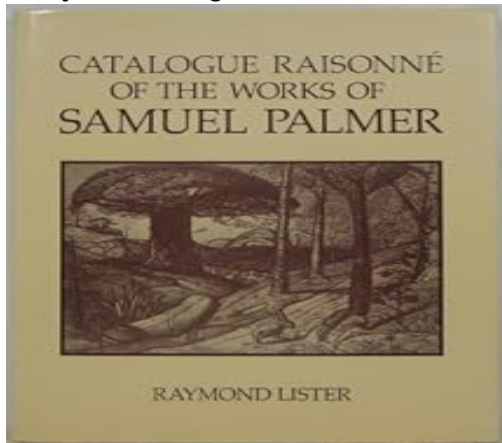


A Catalogue Raisonné of the Works of Samuel Palmer By Raymond Lister

This is the first catalogue raisonné ever published of the works of Samuel Palmer (1805-1881): It lists in detail Palmer's paintings drawings etchings and book illustrations and discusses their artistic and literary sources and techniques. The catalogue aims to be comprehensive -- over 750 works are described although further works may yet come to light they are unlikely to be numerous. Every catalogued work is wherever possible illustrated for purposes of identification next to the catalogue entry: A Catalogue Raisonné of the Works of Samuel Palmer
